Benito Juárez



A Reading

Benito Juárez García (1806-1872), Mexican politician, president of the Republic (1858-1872), considered Mexican national hero and unquestionable representative of the liberal reforming policy of our country. Son of zapoteca pure race natives was born on March 21, 1806 in the community of San Pablo Guelatao (today, Guelatao de Juárez, in the state of Oaxaca). At the age of thirteen years he moved with his family to the city of Oaxaca (today Oaxaca de Juárez). Protected by a Spanish priest, he studied at the seminary of Oaxaca and after at the Institute of Sciences and Arts, where in 1834 he obtained his lawyer degree. On his politician career he became regidor of the City, council of Oaxaca and elected delegate. In 1847 he became governor of the state and in 1848 he was reelected by a period of four years.

Because of his liberal ideas he was jailed, exiled and finally deported to the Cuban city of La Habana and later to the American city of New Orleans (Louisiana). In 1854 he endorsed the Plan of Ayutla that claimed for the creation of a constituent assembly of a federal constitution. He returned to Mexico in 1855 to take part in the liberal revolution. He was justice minister, governor of Oaxaca State and eight times president of México.

He got married on August the thirty one of 1843 with Margarita Maza , on May the fourth of 1858 he installed his government in Veracruz, in 1867 and 1871 was elected president again and finally died on July the eighteen of 1872 in México city because of a heart attack. The republic of Colombia named him “Benemérito de las Americas”.
