What **would** you **do if** you **found** \$ 750,000?

Imaginary situation
(with simple past forms)

Imaginary consequence
(with modals would, might, or could)

If I found \$750,000,

I **wouldn't return** it so fast.

I **might go** to Las Vegas.

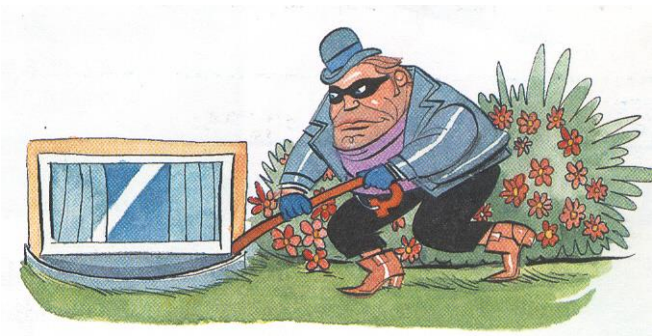
I **could double** it in a casino.

I **would/I'd go to** straight to the police.
