WE USE THIS CONDITIONAL TO TALK ABOUT SOMETHING THAT MAY POSSIBLY HAPPEN IN THE FUTURE.

AFFIRMATIVE	NEGATIVE
<p>If clause (conditional) comma main clause (result)</p> <p>If it rains tonight , we will stay at home</p> <p>If it rains tonight, we will stay at home.</p>	<p>If you don't work, you won't have money. You won't have money if you don't work.</p> <p>If it doesn't stop raining, I won't go to the party. I won't go to the party if it doesn't stop raining.</p> <p>If you arrive late, I won't help you. I won't help you if you arrive late.</p>
INTERROGATIVE	
<p>What will happen if we fail the English test? If we fail the English test, we will repeat the year.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>We will repeat the year if we fail the English test.</p> <p>If you save a lot of money, will you buy a new car? Will you buy a new car if you save a lot of money? Yes, I will. / No, I won't.</p> <p>If Lucy buys car, will she use it go to work? Will Lucy go to work by car if she buys one? Yes, she will. / No, she won't.</p>
